

Comprehension Strategies Timeline

Week 1- Introduce Summarizing

Day 1	 Vocabulary Lesson on the word Summarize (PP in Google Drive) Project the "Example Picture," and do the "Example Warm-up" with students as a whole class (Google Drive) You will use the pictures all the way through these warm-ups, so you might not want to reveal until Week 3.
	 If students are still putting down inferential information for their summary repeat for an additional week with your own pictures.

Week 2- Introduce Literal and Inferential Question Generation

Day 1	 Vocabulary Lesson on Literal vs. Inferential (PP in Google Drive) Distribute Warm-up and have students complete Day 1 Warm-up for Questioning independently

Day 1	 Vocabulary Lesson on Prediction (PP in Google Drive) Distribute "Thinking About How We Think" (Handout in Google Drive) Complete "Thinking About How We Think" Activity 	
Day 2	Complete Example Warm-up as whole class (Students will need their Week 1 Summary Warm-ups and Example picture projected. Now you may want to reveal what the picture is about.)	
Day 3	Warm-up #1 (Week 1 Day 1 Summary warm-up and picture projected)	
Day 4	Warm-up #2 (Week 1 Day 2 Summary warm-up and picture projected)	
Day 5	Warm-up #3 (Week 1 Day 3 Summary warm-up and picture projected)	

Week 4- Introduce Clarifying

Day 1	 Vocabulary Lesson on Clarify (PP in Google Drive) Introduce sentence frames for class use, "Excuse me could you clarify" "I need clarification on" "I don't quite understand what means." Offer extra credit or reward for identifying what is not clear.
Day 2	Warm-up #1
Day 3	Warm-up #2Answer to Riddle Poem: a fish
Day 4	• Warm-up #3
Day 5	 Warm-up #4 Answer to Riddle Poem: the wind

Week 5- Putting it all Together

Day 1	 Students are ready to practice all strategies together. Five days of warm-ups are provided in case that is what is needed. Of course text can be changed for more challenging excerpts if needed. Warm-up #1
